

Pentecost Picnic & Baptism Day

Our special all-church ceremony and picnic will be held this year on **May 19** (the day of Pentecost). While the picnic is for all to enjoy, Baptism is for new and existing Bulli Anglican members who are disciples of Christ, turning 16 or over, and were not baptised as children.

This is a significant and joyful ceremony, where those who come forward will publicly declare their love and devotion to Jesus and acknowledge His sovereignty over their life, by being baptised in his name. It will be held at Bulli Beach with friends & family welcome to attend, alongside our entire church family to witness the occasion.

The day of Pentecost is highly significant as the moment in history when the Holy Spirit descended on Jesus' disciples at Jerusalem. They then spoke publicly about the Lordship of Christ for the first time. Of those who gathered, around 3000 people were convicted by Peter's gospel challenge, and were publicly added to the number of disciples through public baptism that day (Acts 2).

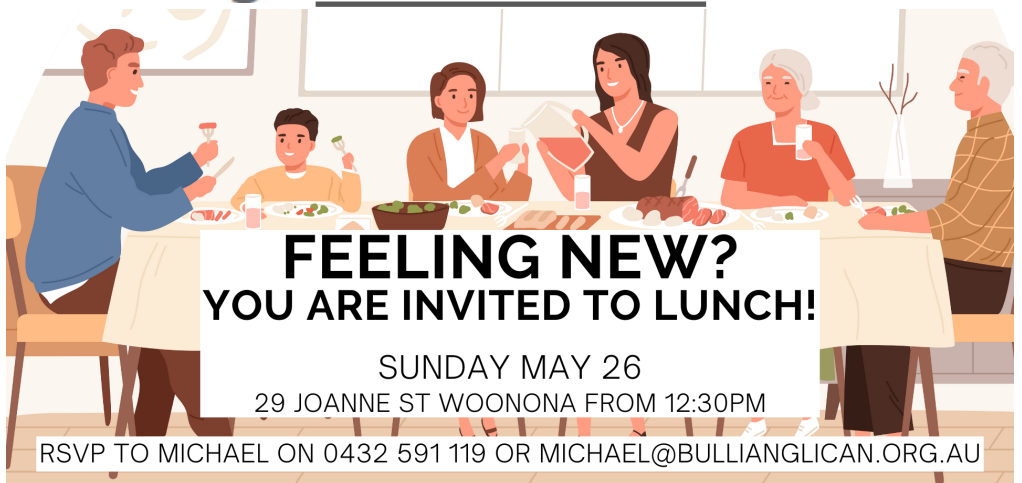

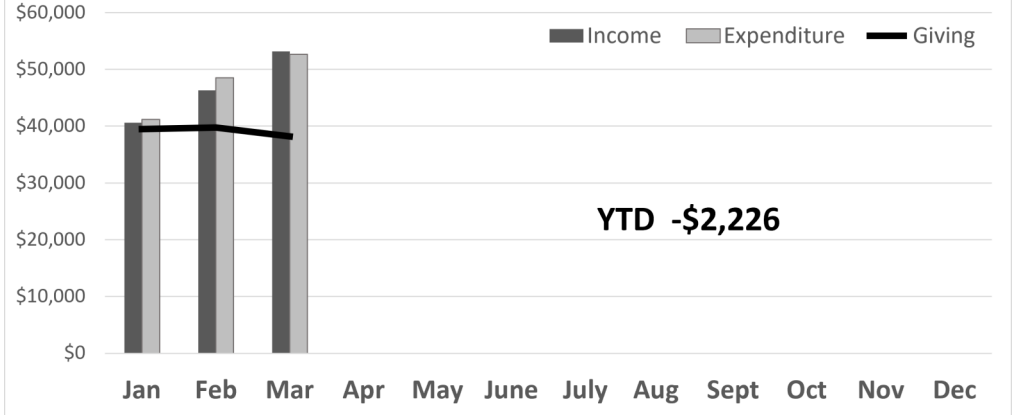
