Mine Disaster Memorial Service

Here at Bulli Anglican we have the privilege of being the host church for the disaster commemoration service.

On March 23, 1887, 81 men and boys lost their lives when the gases in Bulli mine exploded. 150 Bulli children were suddenly left fatherless and 50 women widowed. Each year their relatives, descendants and local dignitaries gather with us to remember the dead, learn lessons from their passing, lay wreaths at the memorial, tour the graveyard, visit the Black Diamond Museum & Heritage Centre and seek comfort together in the gospel of our Lord Jesus.

All members of the community are invited to attend and participate in our shared local history under God.


KYCK 2024—April 26-28


